Tanzania Nursing Scholarship Program

- Tanzania faces an extreme shortage of healthcare providers, especially in rural areas. The country has only two nurses for every 10,000 people.
- Young women who manage to overcome the obstacles and enroll in nursing school are often unable to complete the programs due to lack of funds.
- The DFW grant will more than double the number of women who receive TNSP scholarships over the next few years.

Key Points

- Both health care and education are necessary in order for citizens to participate in the economy.
- Girls face the highest levels of discrimination in accessing education and healthcare.
- Assisting women to become healthcare providers brings benefits to an entire country.
