## Clean Start Africa

**KENYA**

This program will provide sustainable economic opportunities and dignity to women transitioning out of prison, most of whom are poor, illiterate, single mothers and sole breadwinners of their families.

## Kakenya's Dream

**KENYA**

This project will educate and empower marginalized girls who are at risk of female genital mutilation/cutting (FGM/C) and child marriage and provide them with access to a high school education.

## Save the Rain

**TANZANIA**

Through this grant, teams of female builders will be employed to construct residential rainwater harvesting systems and greenhouses to sustain families between rainy seasons.

## Asia Initiatives

**INDIA**

This grant will enable 450 women in remote villages to achieve financial and nutritional independence through organic vegetable gardens, teaching them the skills to maintain and market produce, and improving the nutrition and incomes of themselves, their families, and their communities.

**PERU**

The Adolescent Girls Empowerment Initiative (AGEI) uses a culturally sensitive approach to train adolescent girls from Indigenous communities on sexual and reproductive health topics.

The Stop Girl Trafficking (SGT) Program keeps at-risk girls in school, reducing their susceptibility to trafficking, early marriage, and forced labor.

MAIA's holistic model aims to increase retention rates of Indigenous girls in secondary school while reducing teenage pregnancies.

## Lotus Outreach International **CAMBODIA**

The Girls Access To Education (GATE) project will ensure that girls who face severe poverty, risk of exploitation and trafficking, and lack of educational opportunities are able to complete their secondary education and pursue self-directed lives.

## For the Good **KENYA**

This grant will expand access to education for girls in a remote, high-need region of southern Kenya. It will also provide reusable menstrual pads and sexual and reproductive health and rights education for local girls and women.

This project will train and certify single mothers and at-risk young women in digital literacy and STEM education to alleviate poverty and increase their economic potential.

## Global Fund for Widows **TANZANIA**

This grant will support widows living in poverty to build decent and sustainable livelihoods, enabling them to lead dignified and healthy lives in which they can afford essential goods such as nutrition, schooling for their children, and access to medical care.
