Position Summary

The Communications Writing Internship is a fully remote, unpaid position ideal for someone passionate about nonprofit work, international issues, gender equality, and writing. You will play an active role in supporting the Rise communications team by building a library of content to improve visibility of Together Women Rise and foster a culture of philanthropy within the organization. This internship is perfect for anyone looking for invaluable hands-on writing and communications experience in a dynamic, impactful organization.

Essential Responsibilities

Promote Together Women Rise's mission and engagement opportunities by expanding our visibility through storytelling.

Intern Duties

Working closely with the Communications & Membership Director, and occasionally with the Communications Coordinator, this work will focus on the following projects and deliverables:

- Mission-Centered Content Creation
 - Research and draft blog posts, and educational content on global gender equality issues, philanthropy, and related current events
 - Help translate complex global issues into accessible content for members and broader audiences
- Storytelling
 - Identify potential grantee impact stories and create catalogue to store for future uses
 - Conduct interviews with current and past grantee partners, members, donors, volunteers, and organizational leaders to develop compelling impact stories
 - Draft copy for email campaigns, website pages, newsletters, and social media
- Other Tasks (as time allows)
 - Draft media pitches to support external visibility
 - Create evergreen email sequences, including welcome and re-engagement campaigns
 - Develop evergreen content for executive and organizational LinkedIn and social media platforms
